### STATISTICS FOR 2006

Rescue Missions are overflowing in record numbers nation wide, and Northern Colorado is part of it. Christian Rescue Missions alone recorded 15 million nights lodging which is an increase of 8% over 2005. Open Door Mission is in that record. Homeless people do not go away, they just change in who they are. AGRM (Association of Gospel Rescue Missions) had 47% of those people return to being part of the working community & we are a member. 18,000 graduated from our programs and 10,300 were placed in jobs, and again Open Door Mission is part of those statistics. As long as people need help I will be there to help. Retire? Only when I cannot put a foot on the floor and get out of bed. Step back, possibly. Tired but never retire entirely. Work with a salary or work without, but no matter what Open Door Mission will continue as long as you help. We are all in this together to decrease homelessness and poverty.
