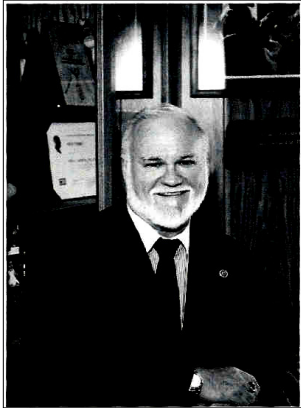

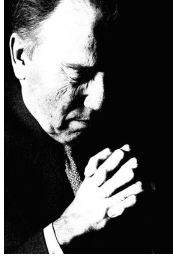

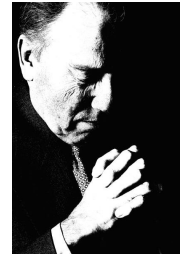

I have mixed feelings about success because it seems we never do enough and yet I see so many people get on their feet and begin a fresh start. Now we have moved on to the next step. A home for at least 2 people who have gone beyond shelter life. Some who come will know Christ as their Savior, some will not. We will judge on character not where they are spiritually. There are good Christians and non-Christians and all are God's creation. We do not turn sinners away, we just reject sin. The house is not a big house as it only has room for 3-4 people. Rev. Thebo will live there and oversee the peoples progress. We are also praying for a 6-8 room house for women. This is a small start to the next step but it is a start. If you would like some information on either project please feel free to call and ask.

Rev. Thebo took the loan out in his name because the realtor said the interest rate would be lower than if it were purchased by a corporation, but the house does belong to the shelter. Please pray for the success of this next step which will help people move from the shelter but still remain in a place that has someone to help them as they move back into society. From the Mission to the world is quite a leap and a little extra help is needed.

We are struggling financially each month because donations have been down. So why the house you may ask. It needed to be done. We paid off the buildings we are in and it seemed reasonable to move forward to the next step.

Please remember that bills go up in the summer not down and that is because we have a lot more people. People's needs also go up. You are still appreciated and drastically needed.
