GOD BLESS YOU!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

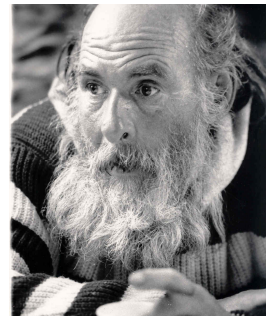
